THE STORY OF OUR WINE LIST

The Rustic Canyon wine list began as a love letter to California. Santa Monica native Josh Loeb founded the restaurant in 2006 after hosting monthly dinners at his family's home nestled in the Rustic Canyon neighborhood. Some of the most memorable moments and conversations revolved around wine—Josh would open special bottles, craft thoughtful pairings, and friends would discover something new they loved. In curating the opening list, Josh showcased those same boutique wineries whose stories he loved to share and featured beautiful wines from all over the Golden State, with a heavy dose of Pinot Noir (including an entire section dedicated to Williams Selyem, one of his inspirations). It also contained old-world favorites from classic regions such as Tuscany, Burgundy and some serious vintage Bordeaux.

The list has had many caretakers over the years - sommeliers who have left their loving marks, including me. I started as a server at Rustic Canyon weeks after it opened and became the sommelier in 2010. As you flip through the pages, it essentially tells the story of all of those who have cared for it—the types of grape varieties they gravitated to, winemakers who got onto their first restaurant list with us, lesser-known regions that are ripe for discovery and more. I'm grateful to each and every one of them for curating the eclectic, nuanced selection we have today.

These days, we're bringing in wines from small producers from all over the world who practice organic, Biodynamic and regenerative farming, including special love for California. I'm proud to say that this wine list has something for everyone. With our new sommelier Jenna Isaacs on the floor, we hope you'll create some new memories here as you sip on a glass or open something special with loved ones.

SPRING FAVORITES

CHAMPAGNE

NV Laherte Freres Les Longues Voyes, Blanc de Noirs, Extra Brut 190

The NV Champagne Premier Cru Blanc de Noirs Les Longes Voyages Extra Brut is rich with pronounced notes of cherry liqueur, toasted graham cracker, and violets. It is well balanced and has a refined mousse, perfect for pairing with garden fresh produce, or even a small plate of crispy potatoes. The Pinot Noirs that make up this cuvée were harvested in 2018 and come from Premier Cru terroirs of the Montagne de Reims. The grapes were harvested at perfect maturity, pressed, then vinified in oak barrels with an aging period of 18 months. The champagne has focused energy and a bouquet of black fruits, wet stone, and a fresh floral note that lingers on the long, delicate finish. It strikes a wonderful balance between power and finesse.

NOT YOUR MOTHER'S LAMBRUSCO

2022 Silvia Zucchi, Lambrusco di Sorbara Rosato, *Lombardy, Italy* 65

Lambrusco doesn't have a great rap in the US, and frankly, that's fair. A lot of it is sweet, mass-produced, and boring. This rosé Lambrusco from Silvia Zucchi is none of those things. The third-generation of her family to make wine in Emilia-Romagna, Silvia farms organically and employs a rare, labor-intensive technique to give the wine its bubbles. The result is a dry, herbal sparkling rosé that's versatile with food, yet refreshing enough to enjoy on its own.

Tastes like: Watermelon, raspberries, thyme, and sea salt.

THE RIESLING TO TRY THIS MONTH

2021 Frecciarossa Gli Orti Riesling, *Oltrepo Pavese, Piedmont Italy* 85

This brilliant, beautiful, crisp white wine will change how you think about riesling, and also remind you how important terroir is. With their first vintage of this riesling debuting in 1921, they've had some time to perfect this iconic, mineral driven expression of riesling. Silky smooth and velvety on the palate, notes of lemon peel, almond, and crunchy white nectarine blend seamlessly. Italian riesling is the moment.

SPRING FAVORITES

SOMM'S PICK ROSÉ

2020 Idlewild Rosé, *North Coast, California*

65

Lovely, tart red plum, rose petals, and juniper aromas with a smooth, dry palate. Made of Mendocino and Sonoma farmed with organic methods, by 4th generation winemaker/grower Sam Bilbro (whose family owns Marietta Cellars).

For the 2020 vintage, this rosé is a co-fermented blend of 41% Nebbiolo, 30% Dolcetto, and 29% Barbera and a touch of Grignolino crafted by Sam with native fermentation using very little sulfites. While the wine is designated as Mendocino County, the fruit largely comes from Fox Hill Vineyard. Located southeast of Ukiah on Mendocino's Talmage Bench, the soils are well drained with high concentrations of gravel and sandstone.. All of our vineyards are farmed organically.

LIKE DISCO LEMONADE...

2021 Yetti & The Kokonut "Mt. Savagnin" *McLaren Vale, Australia*

Rustic Canyon snagged the last eight bottles of this vintage in the United States, and we're super happy to share it with you. This Savagnin is the more serious one of two that is produced at Yetti and the Kokonut. The careful 5 day skin contact works perfectly to add texture without losing freshness, creating a wine with a saline, mineral complexity and nutty notes dancing like a ballerina on top of tropical fruit. Fruit forward with a hint of melon, passionfruit and orange peel, this biodynamic orange is *very* quaffable. We have about three bottles left for the orange wine lovers!

LIGHT & LOVELY RED

2021 Graci Etna Rosso, *Sicily, Italy*

A beautiful, light bodied, unoaked wine from an excellent vintage. Dried cherries, sweet herbs and dried flowers emerge from this delicate red wine. Graci has three vineyard sites, including a single-plot of 13 hectares that Alberto Graci bought together with the charismatic poster-child of natural winemaking Frank Cornelissen, Graci's parcel contains 2 hectares of ungrafted, pre-phylloxera Nerello Mascalese vines planted over 100 years ago. The remainder of the property is planted to olive and apple trees. All Graci's wines see spontaneous fermentation (no selected yeasts or inoculation) and are unfiltered. Extending across the variable volcanic soils of the slopes of Mt. Etna at some of the highest vineyard altitudes in all of Europe—up to 3,300 feet—Nerello Mascalese is one of Sicily's most noble red varieties. It makes a beautifully aromatic, firm, cellar-worthy but pale-hued red often comparable to a fine Burgundy or Barbaresco. Somm Secret—Nerello Mascalese takes its name from the black color of its grapes, nerello, and the Mascali plain between Mt. Etna and the coast where it is believed to have originated.
