THE STORY OF OUR WINE LIST

The Rustic Canyon wine list began as a love letter to California. Santa Monica native Josh Loeb founded the restaurant in 2006 after hosting monthly dinners at his family's home nestled in the Rustic Canyon neighborhood. Some of the most memorable moments and conversations revolved around wine—Josh would open special bottles, craft thoughtful pairings, and friends would discover something new they loved. In curating the opening list, Josh showcased those same boutique wineries whose stories he loved to share and featured beautiful wines from all over the Golden State, with a heavy dose of Pinot Noir. It also contained old-world favorites from classic regions such as Tuscany, Burgundy and some serious vintage Bordeaux.

The list has had many caretakers over the years - sommeliers who have left their loving marks, including me. I started as a server at Rustic Canyon weeks after it opened and became the sommelier in 2010. As you flip through the pages, it essentially tells the story of all of those who have cared for it—the types of grape varieties they gravitated to, winemakers who got onto their first restaurant list with us, lesser-known regions that are ripe for discovery and more. I'm grateful to each and every one of them for curating the eclectic, nuanced selection we have today.

Today Jenna Isaacs is curating our wine list from small producers all over the globe who practice organic, Biodynamic and regenerative farming, with a deep love for California. We believe this list has something for everyone, and our team of dedicated servers and sommelier are always here to help you select the perfect pairing.

SUMMER FAVORITES

CHAMPAGNE

NV **Francois Bedel Entre Ciel & Terre, Brut** 250

A suitable name for a biodynamic Champagne – “between heaven and earth” or Entre Ciel et Terre, comes from vineyards planted on calcareous clay soils .

The NV Brut Entre Ciel Et Terre is a refined wine laced with perfumed peaches, apricots, smoke, flowers and mint. This mid-weight yet generous Champagne offers gorgeous depth and richness, with a long, refined finish. The hand-harvested Ciel et Terre shows more than enough complexity and nuance to offer fine drinking now and over the next few years. Though labeled a NV wine, Entre Ciel Et Terre is a single vintage wine (in this case 2003), made up of 41% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir and 24% Meunier that spent 12 months in oak and was bottled with 4 grams of dosage. This is a highly rated, rare Champagne we absolutely love, and have 6 bottles available to share with you.

IT'S LAMBRUSCO SEASON

2022 **Silvia Zucchi, Lambrusco di Sorbara Rosato, Lombardy, Italy** 65

This lovely rosé Lambrusco from Silvia Zucchi is bright, bubbly, and bursting with flavors of fresh berries and thyme blossoms. The third-generation of her family to make wine in Emilia-Romagna, Silvia farms organically and employs a rare, labor-intensive technique to give the wine its bubbles. The result is a dry, lightly floral sparkling rosé that's versatile with food, yet refreshing enough to enjoy on its own.

IL PRIMO AMORE NON SI SCORDA MAI

2020 **Due Del Monte Malvasia, Friuli-Venezia Giulia Collio DOC, Italy** 98

This barrel-fermented Malvasia is completely irresistible. Elegant aromas of tropical fruit, jasmine flowers, white tea, and almond. The palate is silky smooth, with the perfect amount of acidity to keep it feeling bright and refreshing without losing its sense of luxuriousness.

This wine is made by Miran Buzinel, who grew up in a family of winemakers on the border of Slovenia. Knowing that wine was his path, he traveled to learn new techniques in Canada, Chile, and Australia- eventually landing the position as winemaker at Borgo del Tiglio, back home in Italy. During his ten years there he created arguably the world's best malvasia and some of Italy's most beloved white wines. In 2018 he began to form a new team for Due del Monte, with the very clear objective: make great wines.

We were lucky enough to have Miran visit us here at Rustic Canyon, and generously supply us with his highly sought after wines. There are currently 5 bottles left of this rare wine for 2024.

SUMMER FAVORITES

SPOTLIGHT WHITE...

2021 **Sea Smoke Chardonnay, Sta. Rita Hills, California** 230

Rustic Canyon snagged this allocation of luxurious Chardonnay for wine lovers in the know.

Known for its power, complexity, and silky smooth texture, Sea Smoke is the perfect California Chardonnay. The winemaker describes this vintage as an “elegant Chardonnay with aromas of Meyer lemon zest, fresh cut melon and honeycomb”

The estate vineyard is located in the northern hemisphere’s southernmost – and sunniest – Region 1 microclimate, which has the coolest temperatures for grape growing. The Pacific Ocean fog (‘sea smoke’) funnels across their hillsides each afternoon, creating ideal growing conditions for excellent Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

2023 **Camins 2 Dreams Red Blend, Sta. Rita Hills, California** 95

(special release, only 10 cases made)

One of our sommelier’s favorites, this vibrant, chillable blend is perfect for kicking off Summer. This wine is a bright, juicy blend of grenache, syrah, and carignan aged in stainless steel. The colorful label is a special edition for Pride Month.

Made by incredible wife and wife winemakers Tara and Mireah (Tara is Native American, and Mireah was born and raised in Catalunya) the two fell in love over their passion for wine and travel. Tara was recently awarded “2021 Winemaker of the Year” by VinePair and “2022 Winemaker of the Year” by The Hue Society and “2023 Future 40” by Wine Enthusiast She is honored and humbled to receive such a prestigious award and see all of her hard work, dedication, and perseverance not just seen, but celebrated.

And, as if enjoying delightful wine made by two wonderful women wasn’t enough, 60% of the profits earned from this wine are donated to Santa Ynez Pride and The Rainbow House! Only a few bottles remain, so grab one before they’re gone.

2020 **Brendan Stater West, Cabernet France, Saumur, Loire Valley, France** 100

A beautiful, medium bodied, cabernet franc from an excellent vintage. Dried cherries, dark plum, sweet herbs and gentle spices emerge from this dynamic red wine.

A little over a decade ago, young expat Brendan Stater-West, then working as a waiter in Paris, had an “aha!” moment drinking a bottle of cult-producer Romain Guiberteau’s top white, Brézé. Soon after, he talked his way into a job at that venerable Saumur address, where he still works as Guiberteau’s assistant winemaker.

When you don’t know what to pair with a variety of foods from beets, to prawns, to pasta, to the pork chop, this wine is the perfect go-to.
